Scope of Work for Reconditioning of 1000kW DC motor of Hot Sheet/Strip Mill.

The detailed scope of work for reconditioning of 1000kW DC motor includes following list of works:-

I. Works to be performed :-

1. Dismantling the motor from its location at MIDHANI.
2. Dismantling, De-soldering, Cleaning & Stripping of core
3. Checking IR values and resistance of armature, field, interpole and compensating windings before overhauling and improving IR values.
4. Epoxy Gel coating on all the windings.
5. Repair of Commutator i.e., Commutator turning on Lathe Machine, Mica under cutting and beveling between the segments also includes checking and replacement of commutator risers, segments and soldering joints.
6. Replacement of carbon brushes, holders and springs and with new one's. New Carbon brushes, holders and springs are in supplier's scope. The brushes, holders and springs are to be designed as per the drawing given by MIDHANI.
7. Checking IR Values, resistance and inductance of all windings post overhauling.
8. Checking condition of drive and non drive side bearings and a report on condition of bearings to be given.
9. Armature Dynamic Balancing
10. Checking IR values, resistance and inductance values of armature post overhauling.
11. Reassembling, Testing and painting.
 - a. As a part of testing IR test and dynamic balancing post overhauling are to be carried out.
12. Assembling the motor back in its position at MIDHANI and carrying out no load test.
13. After assembling the motor back at MIDHANI the performance of overhauled DC motor is to be tested for rolling of various grades of MIDHANI.

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13. Apart from above works the following list of works if necessary are to be carried out by the supplier after the condition of motor is assessed by MIDHANI. The condition will be assessed after the motor is completely dismantled at supplier's site. The price for each of these works shall be quoted separately in price bid.

- a. Rewinding of armature includes manufacture, supply and replacement of armature winding.
- b. Rewinding of field includes manufacture, supply and replacement of field winding.
- c. Rewinding of interpole includes manufacture, supply and replacement of interpole winding.
- d. Replacement of compensating winding includes manufacture, supply and replacement of compensating winding.
- e. Supply of two sets of Carbon brushes, springs and Holders of full quantity.
- f. Any other works apart from above mentioned shall be included by the party along with price.

II. Utmost care should be taken during dismantling, repair and assembly. In all probabilities, the existing bearings are to be retained as removal of gear coupling may not be possible. Hence it is to be ensured that bearings are handled carefully during the reconditioning.

III. All the parties shall quote the price of every work mentioned above separately in price bid.

IV. Transportation of motor from MIDHANI to supplier's site and from supplier's site to MIDHANI is under MIDHANI's scope.

V. Motor shall be dismantled from its location by the party only after receiving site clearance from MIDHANI.

VII. Pre-qualification Criteria. -

1) The bidder shall have experience in carrying out similar type of overhauling works for BHEL make separately excited DC Shunt motors of rolling mills of about 400 kW rating and above capacities which are working satisfactorily.

2) The Bidder shall enclose document proof for the works carried out along with their offer.

VIII. Before submitting their techno-commercial offer the bidder must visit the site with prior intimation to see the existing 1000kW DC Shunt motor and its assembly at MIDHANI on any working day from 10.00 AM to 04.00 PM with prior intimation to Sr. Manager (P-III Electrical).

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IX. PRE DISPATCH INSPECTION. - Pre dispatch Inspection shall be carried out by Midhani at supplier's site for 1000kW DC shunt motor as per scope of supply for inspection, with possible functional tests, before dispatch.

X. GUARANTEE. - The firm shall stand guarantee for a period of one year from the date of delivery for workmanship. Any defects of workmanship found in this period shall be carried out by the party free of cost.

XI. DELIVERY PERIOD. - Within 16 weeks from the date of receipt of motor.

XII. ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA. - The supplier shall ensure the performance of overhauled DC motor after re-commissioning for rolling of various grades of MIDHANI.

NOTE.-

1. The 1000 kW DC motor is in working condition. And its stator winding is having two halves. and rotor shaft is mounted on bearing stands outside of motor Body on the Mill floor.
2. Old coil/ carbon brushes, holders or else any spares removed from the motor shall be returned back to MIDHANI.
3. The reports of all tests carried out like IR test, Resistance and Inductance test, No load trail Test, Dynamic Balancing must be submitted along with the motor.

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GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Any Order resulting from this invitation to tender shall be governed by our General Terms and Conditions of Contract and the supplier quoting against this enquiry shall be deemed to have read and understood the same.
2. Where counter terms and conditions have been offered by the Tenderer, the purchaser shall not be governed by these unless specific acceptances have been given in writing in the order by the Purchaser.
3. The offer should be complete in all respects. Full Particulars and descriptive literature and drawing should be forwarded along with the quotation. The make of the items offered should be clearly specified. Materials should be offered strictly conforming to our specifications. The deviations if any should be clearly indicated in the quotation. Test Certificates must be produced, wherever required. Material conforming to IS will be preferred.

4. **PRICES**

Price Basis: FOR Midhani, Hyderabad basis.

The Prices must be per unit shown inclusive of packing forwarding insurance Octroi duty and delivery charges and should be on FOR destination basis, Offers from local suppliers should be for free delivery at our Stores.

5. **TAXES AND DUTIES:**

The Tenderer shall indicate their Central & State Sales Tax Registration Nos. & date in the quotation.

- i) If Excise duty or any other charges are payable by the Purchaser, the same must be specifically stated in the offer and payment of such Excise Duty and other duties shall be allowed as applicable at sale point on the production of documentary evidence.

The Contractor has to furnish transporters copy of Invoice along with supplies for availing Cenvat credit.

- ii) SALES TAX: Sales Tax will be paid by the Purchaser at the sale point if legally leviable at the rate ruling on the date of supply. The percentage of Sales Tax applicable should be indicated. Central Sales Tax will be payable at concessional rates against "C" form on materials covered under Sales Tax Registration.

6. **DELIVERY:**

The Delivery Period shall be within 16 weeks Months from the date of Receipt of Motor (As per S. No XI of Technical Specification)

7. **TERMS OF PAYMENT:**

For Supply: 90% value alongwith 100% Taxes and duties against receipt after Pre dispatch inspection at your works.

For Service: 90% value along with 100% Taxes against Successful completion of Job on Indentor's certification.

Balance 10% Payment shall be after acceptance and submission of Performance Bank Guarantee for 10% order value valid till Guarantee Period.

8. WARANTEE:

9. INSPECTION:
As per S. No IX of Technical Specification.
10. TO RECOVER LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:
In the event of unsatisfactory, delayed or non supply of materials, the supplier shall be liable to pay by way of liquidated damages at the rate of 1% of the total contract prices per week or part there of subject to a maximum 10% of the contract price without prejudice to the right of the purchaser to take any other action. The amount shall also be recoverable from any other contract on account of the supplier.
11. RISK PURCHASE:
The supply of all items must be completed satisfactorily and within the specified period in the order falling which the Purchaser reserves the right to purchase stores from other sources at the supplier's cost and risk.
12. PACKING:
The stores should be securely packed and properly marked to avoid loss or damage in Transit by Rail / Road.
13. VALIDITY:
THE OFFER SHOULD BE VALID FOR A MINIMUM PERIOD OF 180 DAYS FROM THE OPENING OF QUOTATION.
14. RIGHT OF ACCEPTANCE:
THE PURCHASER DOES NOT BIND HIMSELF TO ACCEPT THE LOWEST OR ANY OF OTHER TENDER AND RESERVES THE RIGHT OF ACCEPTANCE THE WHOLE OR ANY PART OF THE TENDER OR PORTION OF THE QUANTITY OFFERED.
15. ARBITRATION:
Any dispute or difference whatsoever arising between the parties out of or relating to the construction, meaning and operation or effect of this Contract or the breach thereof shall be settled by Arbitration in accordance with the Rules of Arbitration of the Indian Council of Arbitration and the award made in pursuance thereof shall be binding on the parties.
16. JURISDICTION:
All questions, disputes or differences arising under, out of or in connection with the contract shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of court within local limits of Hyderabad, Andhra Pradesh, India.
17. S.S.I. UNITS:
If Tenderer happens to be a SSI Unit with single point registration with NSIC, shall furnish details of turn over besides SSI Registration Certificate Copy along with the Tender. SSI Units seeking exemption from payment of EMD shall furnish necessary documentary proof to the satisfaction of the Purchaser in terms of Government Guidelines.

19. **SECURITY DEPOSIT:**

23. NO CLAIM OR COMPENSATION FOR SUBMISSION OF TENDER:

The tenderers whose tenders are not accepted shall not be entitled to claim any costs, charges and expenses of the tender, incidental to or incurred by them, through or in connection with their submission of tenders even though the Purchaser may elect to withdraw the invitation to tender.

24. LOWEST TENDER NOT NECESSARY TO BE ACCEPTED:

The Tenderers whose tenders are not accepted shall not be entitled to claim any costs, charges and expenses of the tender, incidental to / or incurred by them, through or in connection with their submission of tenders, even though the Purchaser may elect to withdraw the Invitation to Tender.

25. BANKRUPTCY ETC.:

If the Contractor shall become bankrupt or insolvent or cause or suffer any receiver to be appointed of his business or any asset thereof or compound with his creditors, or being a corporation commence to be wound up, or carry on its business under a Receiver for the benefits of its creditors or any of them, the Purchaser shall be at liberty:

- a. To terminate the contract forthwith upon coming to know of the happening of any such event as aforesaid by notice in writing to the Contractor or to the receiver / liquidator.

OR

- b. To give such receiver, liquidator or other person the option of carrying out the contract subject to his providing guarantee up to an amount to be agreed for the due and faithful performance of the Contract.

26. TENDER OPENING:

A) TECHNO-COMMERCIAL BIDS (UN-PRICED) :

Techno-commercial Bids (un-priced) only shall be opened on the due date indicated in the enquiry at the time of tender opening.

B) PRICE BIDS:

PRICE Bids of technically acceptable tenders' shall be opened after the Techno-commercial bids evaluation and after receipt of clarifications, if any, at the time and date which will be informed to the tenderers concerned in advance.

The comparative assessment of offers received would be made on equal footing taking into account the financial implications for the deviations in terms and conditions. Conditional discounts offered by the tenderers for coverage within a shorter period for early inspection / payment etc., shall not be considered at the time of evaluation of tenders.

27. DEFINITIONS:

PURCHASER:

The term "Purchaser" as used herein shall mean Mishra Dhatu Nigam Limited, incorporated under the Companies Act, 1956, and having its registered office at P.O. Kanchanbagh, Hyderabad - 500 058, India, and shall include its successors and assigns.

TENDERER:

The term "Tenderer" shall mean the person, firm or corporation submitting a tender against the Invitation to tender and shall include his/its heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, successors and assigns.

CONTRACTOR:

The term "Contractor" shall mean the Tenderer whose tender has been accepted and shall include his/is heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, successors and assigns approved by the Purchaser.

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INSTRUCTIONS TO THE TENDERER FOR ONLINE SUBMISSION OF QUOTATION

1(a). The Tender has to be submitted in TWO BID SYSTEM failing which the tender will be liable for rejection. All technical matters, Testimonials, credentials, commercial conditions has to be mentioned in Cover-I i.e. Technical Bid and Price has to be mentioned in Cover-II i.e. Price Bid (BOQ).(Note: The other commercial terms & conditions of your quotation/offer should be mentioned separately in **ATC (Agreed Terms and Condition)** which will be downloaded and upload the same in cover I). All bids are to be submitted on-line on the website <http://eprocuramidhani.gov.in> **No bid shall be accepted off-line.**

1(b). No consideration for wrong entries/errors will be allowed and firms are advised to carefully indicate the applicable taxes and duties amount.

2. Technical Specification: Technical Specification containing the technical parameters for tendered item will be in PDF format and will be downloaded by the bidder and he will furnish all the required information in PDF file. Thereafter, the bidder will upload the technical specification of the quoted item in PDF file during bid submission. Non-compliance of any one specification parameter of the item will disqualify the bidder in that item. The Technical specification which is incomplete and not submitted as per instruction given above will be rejected.

3. Price bid: The Price bid containing the Bill of Quantity will be in Excel format and will be downloaded by the bidder and he will quote the rates, taxes & duties etc. for his offered items on this Excel file. Thereafter, the bidder will upload the same Excel file during bid submission in respective folder. The Price-bid will be in Item-wise Rate BOQ format ~~and the bidder may quote for any or all the tendered items and the L-1 will be decided for each item separately.~~ The Price-bids of the tenderers will have no condition. The Price Bid which is incomplete and not submitted as per instruction will be rejected.

4. The “General Terms & Conditions” as mentioned in the NIT shall form an integral part of the NIT and will also form a part of the Supply Orders placed against this tender.

5. Clarification of Bid: The bidder may seek clarification on-line within the specified period. His identity will not be disclosed by the system. However, the management will clarify as far as possible the relevant queries. The clarifications given by the department will be visible to all the bidders or only the bidder who raised the clarification query , intending to participate in the tender.

6. Submission of Bid:

a. In order to submit the Bid, the bidders have to get themselves registered online on the e-Procurement portal <http://eprocuremidhani.gov.in> with valid Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) of Class III issued from any agency authorized by Controller of Certifying Authority (CCA), Govt. of India. The online Registration of the Bidders on the portal will be free of cost and one time activity only.

b. The bidders have to accept unconditionally the on-line user portal agreement which contains the acceptance of all the Terms and Conditions of NIT including Commercial & General Terms & Conditions, along with on-line undertaking in support of the authenticity of the declarations regarding the facts, figures, information and documents furnished by the Bidder on-line in order to become an eligible bidder. No conditional bid shall be accepted.

c. In case the Tender Committee finds that there is some error/omission in scanning & uploading the Technical Cover document by a bidder, the same will be specified on-line under shortfall documents by Evaluator normally within short duration of Technical-bid (Part-I) opening, indicating the start date and end date giving specific time for on-line submission by bidder. The bidder will get the intimation about this through a standard system generated e-mail and will re-upload the same within specified period. No additional time will be allowed for on-line submission of document.

7. Modification and Withdrawal of Bid: The bidder may modify and resubmit the bid on-line as many times as he/she may wish, only before the deadline of submission of tender.

8. **Firm Price:** Price quoted shall be firm and fixed till complete execution of order.

9. **PRICES:** Prices quoted must be FIRM till delivery, otherwise the offer will be rejected. The destination point for delivery of materials will be as follows:

The bidder will be responsible for safe arrival of materials to the destination points as mentioned above. However, the unloading and stacking of materials will be the responsibility of the consignee. The bidders should quote their **unit rate** on FOR (Free on Road/Rail) destination basis in a specified format containing the breakup of applicable taxes and duties, freight, insurance and other components of the price in absolute value along with the basic price of each item. The L1 bidder will be decided by the system on the basis of landed price inclusive of all taxes and duties as applicable ~~for each item~~. It will be calculated automatically by the system based on the price quoted by the bidders, by summing up the basic rate with other price elements, as given by the bidders on-line. Non submission of any price component by bidder will be taken as 'zero' by the system, the evaluation will be done accordingly and that price element will be assumed to be included in the basic price quoted by the bidder. Bidders are requested to indicate Excise Duty and Service Tax separately in the BOQ wherever applicable.

10. After evaluation of Techno-commercial bid, all the bidders will get the information regarding status of their eligibility along with the date of Price-bid opening on their personalized dash board and also by system generated e-mail. It will be the bidder's responsibility to check the status of their Bid on-line at least once daily, after the opening of Techno-commercial bid till opening of the Price-bid. No separate communication will be made to the bidder in this regard.

11. The Bidder, who's Bid has been accepted, will be notified of the award on-line and also by registered post by the employer prior to expiration of the bid validity period. The L-1 bidder will get the information regarding award of work on their personalized dashboard on-line. On receipt of Letter for Acceptance (LOA)/Work Order of the tender issued by the MIDHANI, the successful tenderer shall execute contract agreement in the company's prescribed form for the due fulfillment of the contract. Failure to enter into the required contract within the specified period in the work order shall entail cancellation of LOA/work order and forfeiture of the Earnest Money. The written contract to be entered into between the contractor and the MIDHANI, shall be the foundation of the rights of both the parties and the contract shall not be deemed to be executed until the contract is signed by both the parties i.e. Contractor and the MIDHANI.

13. **Currencies of Bid and Payment:** The unit rates shall be quoted by the Bidder entirely in Indian Rupees only.

14. It is the bidder's responsibility to comply with the system requirement i.e. hardware, software and internet connectivity at bidder's premises to access the e-tender website. Under any circumstances, MIDHANI shall not be liable to the bidders for any direct/indirect loss or damages incurred by them arising out of incorrect use of the e-tender system or internet connectivity failures.
